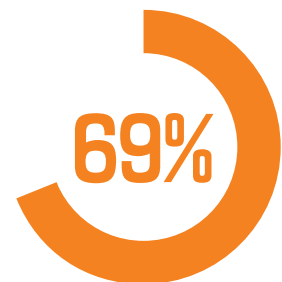

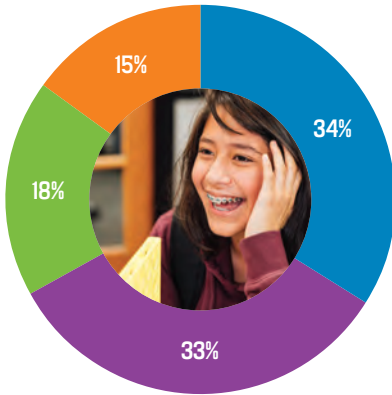

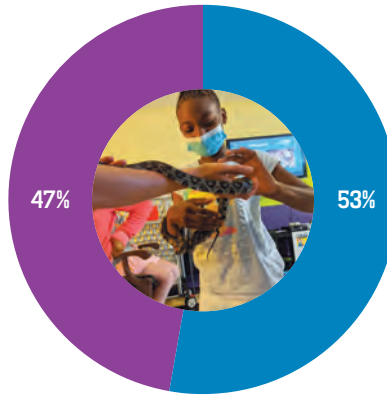

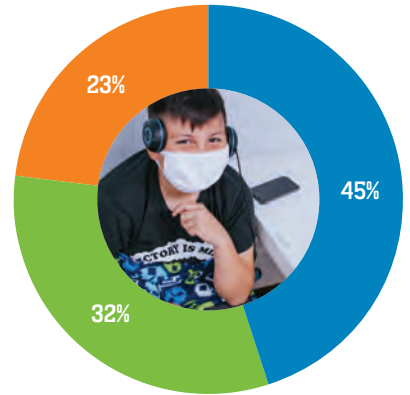

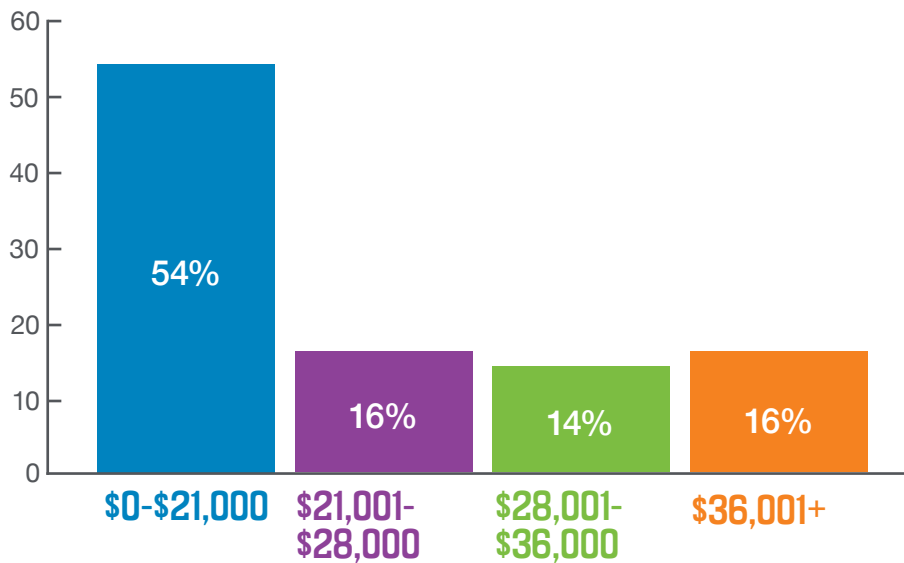

Friends,

I used to hate roller coasters. The instant the lap bar smashed me into my seat, my heart sank. I dreaded the terrifying hurtle over the crest of the hill when the tracks disappeared from sight. With eyes squeezed shut, I'd finish the ride blind and white-knuckling until the train finally stopped.

2020 was one heck of a ride, but because of the heart of frontline program staff and the heroic support of our board, partners and donors, we were swift, nimble and grounded in meeting our kids exactly where they are. Despite whiplash-inducing circumstances, it turned out to be a banner year at the Club!

Change was constant. We shifted our operating model five different times in the span of nine months, we expanded services, hired additional program staff and doubled daily hours of operation. We partnered with schools, invited teachers into our summer classrooms and transformed into a remote learning center during the school year. We added two mental health counselors to our team and launched a comprehensive Social Emotional Learning initiative. We also created, collected, and distributed PPE and thousands of meals in the community and hosted COVID-19 testing sites.

Best of all, we supported 953 young people and helped breadwinners in 671 separate households return to work.

While this was amazing, the ride is far from over.

Today, our kids need academic recovery, structure, consistency, good old-fashioned play and the chance to reconnect with one another *in real life*. They also need programs that promote good decision-making and healthy lifestyles as well as caring adults and experiences that reinforce the grit and tenacity required for our country's comeback.

For this next lap around the tracks, there will be new work to do. It will require growth, guts and imagination. The good news is we're ready. And because of you, we're able.

For this next ride, let's buckle in, side-by-side, with eyes wide open, arms up and grinning as the train shoots over the rails.

Climb aboard. Let's do it.

15 Teens took part in our R.I.S.E. program, designed to teach youth critical soft skills, provide exposure to a variety of career paths, and offer real world experience in community businesses and organizations through job shadowing and internships.

Vision: Teen Club members develop the knowledge, skills, experiences, and confidence to be work and life ready.

At The Club: Youth receive career and college readiness certification through mentorships, targeted life-skills courses, and completion of community service projects.

In The Community: Teens are matched with a business for job shadowing or short-term internships.

CLASS OF 2022 & 2023, PROJECT HOPE.

Members in the classes of 2022 & 2023 have been working diligently to prepare for their future with new partners, David & Terri Luck. The Luck's vision, **Project Hope**, is "finish line college funding" designed to help deserving teens bridge the financial gap between high school and higher education. Qualifying graduates have the opportunity to earn financial assistance to remove the financial barrier to postsecondary education.





XZAVIER JACOBS

Xzavier has been walking the halls of the Club since 2010. While he started with us as a timid third-grader, in 2020 he received the highest achievement a Boys & Girls Club member can receive – Youth of the Year. The title recognizes a member’s leadership, character and service, academic excellence, and healthy lifestyle.

“I would like to thank the Boys & Girls Club for everything they have done for me. From programs that taught me how to create a resume and nail a job interview, to giving me my first job. Without the Club I wouldn’t know how to express my point of view or take a look at things from someone else’s perspective. I was given the encouragement, help, and time to concentrate on school that made me feel like I could achieve anything and placed me on A/B honor roll. I would not be the man I am today without the Club.”

Xzavier is currently enrolled at NC A&T studying business management. While balancing a busy schedule, he still makes time to come back to the Club to inspire the next generation of Club achievers.

As the Boys & Girls Club Corporate Champion, Hunter Subaru provided \$1,000 in college aid to Xzavier for winning the Youth of the Year title.
