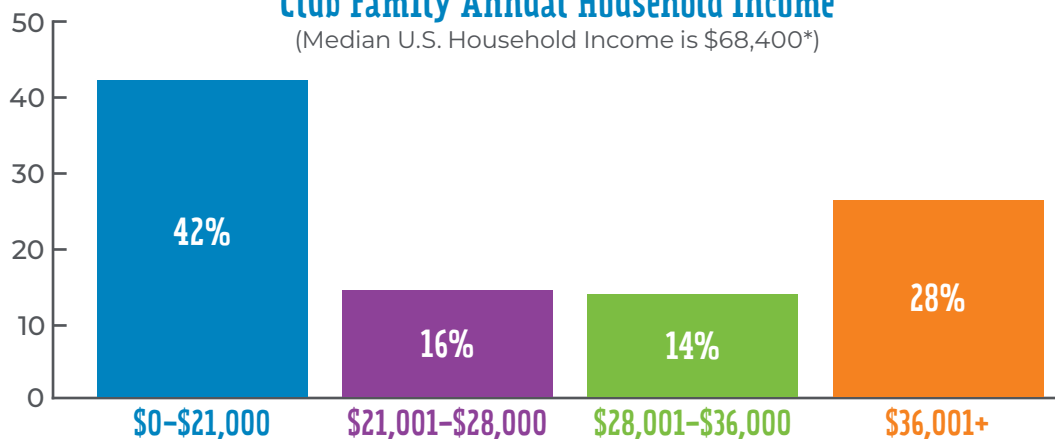

## Congratulations to Our Youth of the Year – Marcella Daniel!

2021's Youth of the Year was Marcella Daniel – a “lifelong” Club member, having been with us since 1st grade. The Youth of the Year title recognizes a member's leadership character and service, academic excellence and healthy lifestyle.

"This was a year of angst, grief and loss, but through it all the Club has been a steady and constant source of support," Daniel said in her speech, noting new challenges of a post-COVID world like virtual school and social isolation. "During the pandemic, I lost motivation and fell behind in school. The sadness, anger and anxiety made me feel like I carried bricks on my back. But the staff at the Club were there for me. I learned to open up and connect with others. At the Club I learned to take care of myself."

As Youth of the Year, Marcella was awarded a \$1,000 college aid award from Hunter Subaru.

She plans to use the funds in her pursuit of becoming a Speech Therapist at UNC Greensboro.

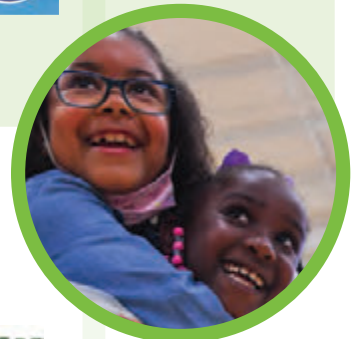
